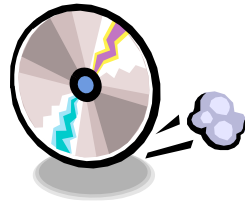

The Mixman enables you to mix samples of music to create your own music in true DJ style! If you are not into House Music or Hip Hop, don't despair, there is a wealth of styles to access: drum & bass, techno, trance, reggae, disco, country, funky, world music and more!

You simply choose a style, load a song and remix it! Music can be saved and burned onto CD.

- Add your own voice and WAV files to the mix (microphone needed)
- W.A.R.P. (Wideband Audio Real – time Processing) joystick
- Dual independent Scratching rings for that real DJ sound!
- Transformer controls – to punch up the volume on selected tracks
- Cross fader – ease it, jam it, whip it back and forth between the decks
- Solo button – break down the mix and solo any track.
- 16 Track buttons – access digital audio tracks, vocals, beats, effects etc.

The Mixman can be used on laptops or in primary school computer suites. Apart from the computers, 10 Mixmans, microphones, speakers and CDs are provided and kept at the schools for the term.
