**Type of support available: (Generic) for Primary and Secondary schools.**

- Supporting schools in producing high quality teaching materials
- Supporting teachers in their 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year of teaching
- Disseminating materials relating to best practice and education research
- Providing 'model' lessons to a whole class, or target group of pupils e.g. talented and gifted, Special Needs etc.
- Supporting a subject leader with regard to schemes of work, policies or management skills
- Observing lessons and advising other teachers on classroom organisation, lesson planning and teaching methods
- Providing subject specific support for NQTs.
- Helping teachers who are experiencing difficulties
- Participation in the induction and mentoring of NQTs
- Leading professional learning groups
- Providing advice and support for Support staff
- Providing advice and guidance and subject based resources
- Providing support for primary/secondary/transition/liaison projects
- The use of ICT to promote learning
- Subject leadership and management
- Guidance of providing differentiation
