



# Fiddlesticks

3 – 6 players

- One person shuffles and deals the cards equally between the players
- Players look at their cards and if they have a set of 2 matching cards, they place them face up on the table.
- The dealer then offers his/her remaining cards face down to the player on their left who takes one.
- If that player is then able to make a pair, these cards are placed with the others already on the table.
- If he/she cannot make a pair, play moves on to the other player.
- Play continues in this way until all the pairs have been found.
- Whoever is left with the fiddlestick is the loser!
